

Gwynt y Mor Offshore Wind Farm Ltd (GYMOWFL) has received a Marine Licence from Natural Resources Wales to carry out a controlled explosion on three suspected German World War II bombs within Gwynt y Mor Offshore Wind Farm, in Liverpool Bay, at the following locations:

Target 1 53 26.35 N 03 37.57 W

Target 2 53 26.27 N 03 37.49 W

Target 3 53 26.28 N 03 37.51 W

These works will be carried out by RAMORA UK and will be utilising the multicat vessel "Suffolk Spirit". Suffolk Spirit can be contacted at any time on VHF 16.



There is a 1000m safety exclusion zone in place from 0001hrs Tuesday 18th March 2014 until further notice centred on the following position:

WGS 84 UTM zone 30



Guard Vessel "Isadale" will be on location to assist with the monitoring of the safety exclusion zone and can also be contacted at any time on VHF 16.


