

## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

## KAMES TO BUTE 33kV SUBMARINE CABLE REPAIR

13<sup>th</sup> February 2015

Mariners are advised that Briggs Marine Contractors Limited will be undertaking submarine power cable repair works between Kames and Bute.

The works will be carried out between 55°53.29´N 05°12.83´W and 55°53.28´N 05°12.96´W.

Marine operations will be running from Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> February 2015 to Friday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2015.

Operations will be carried out from the vessels Forth Guardsman and Forth Jouster. Forth Guardsman will perform cable repair operations using a 4 point mooring pattern offshore. Forth Guardsman will be supported by Forth Jouster as Anchor Handling Tug / Dive Support Vessel Vessel. During cable repair operations, Forth Guardsman will be **restricted in the ability to manoeuvre**. It is requested that all vessels operating within this area maintain a safe distance and pass at minimum speed.

During operations the vessels will display the appropriate day shapes/signals and at times of reduced visibility the appropriate lights as required by the IRPCS. The vessels will also actively transmit an AIS signal. A continuous listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 16 and DSC.
