
“Ndurance” - Subsea Export Cable Works

Duration: From 17th June 2015 until further notice.

Please be advised that on or around 17th June 2015, The cable vessel “Ndurance” is expected to arrive on location for RWE to commence works on a subsea export cable in approx. position, Lat: 53°21.86’N, Long 003°35.8’W.

The vessel will predominantly be connected to a 6 leg anchor pattern and all vessels are asked to give a wide berth of a recommended 1000m to avoid any clash with anchor patterns and surface buoys. Ndurance will be supported by the AHTS / Multicats “Whalsa Lass” and “Marilyn M”

All vessels will be carrying out a listening watch on VHF 16 at all times.




Admiralty Chart Layout of Gwynt y Mor including Export Cable Routes
