

# NOTICE TO MARINERS

## MOSSBANK - YELL 33kV SUBMARINE CABLE

### SURVEY OPERATIONS

---

10<sup>th</sup> September 2015

Mariners are advised that Briggs Marine Contractors Limited will be undertaking submarine power cable survey operations in Yell Sound.

The works will be carried out between in a corridor 250m either side of the centre line between Mossbank 60°27.390' N, 01°10.584' W and Yell 60°29.088' N, 01°8.880' W.

Marine operations will be running from no earlier than Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> September for around two weeks.

Operations will be carried out from the vessel Humber Guardian. During operations, Humber Guardian will be **restricted in the ability to manoeuvre**. It is requested that all vessels operating within this area maintain a safe distance and pass at minimum speed.

Operations will be carried out during the hours of daylight, during which the vessel will display the appropriate day shapes/signals and at times of reduced visibility the appropriate lights as required by the IRPCS. The vessel will also actively transmit an AIS signal. A continuous listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 16 and DSC.
