### **Recovery of Subsea components**


As part of the ongoing development program, and to facilitate system upgrades, some sub-sea components will be recovered from the company's Agreement for Lease (AfL) area in the Holyhead Deep (Details below) and landed at the **PORT OF HOLYHEAD**.

This work will be carried out by the vessels **BOKA FALCON** and **LYNAS SHUTTLE** (Details below).

Work is due to commence on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> March 19 and will take approximate 4 days to complete.

#### **Overview of the Operational Area**

The operation will take place approximately 6 km West of South Stack, off the coast of Anglesey, North West Wales, in the southern section of the AfL area.



#### Safety Zone

A safety Zone of 500m will be re-established on a position 53° 17′ 47.739″ N 004° 47′ 45. 493″ W and will remain in force during the operation.
