Western Link Project

Cable installed in Irish Sea – Urgent operations

Mariners are advised that urgent operations are required to an offshore section installed during the Western Link Campaign 6 in the Irish Sea as detailed in **Table 1**.

Operations are planned to start around the 17th April 2019. Vessels involved in the operations at the location identified in Table 1, are DP2 Vessel “OLYMPIC ARTEMIS” (Call Sign C6BX7) and DP3 Vessel “LEWEC CONNECTOR” (Call Sign 3EZX8).

Vessels are requested to pass at a safe speed and distance and fishing vessels are advised to remain a safe distance (approximately 1.5 nautical miles) from the areas identified in Table 1.

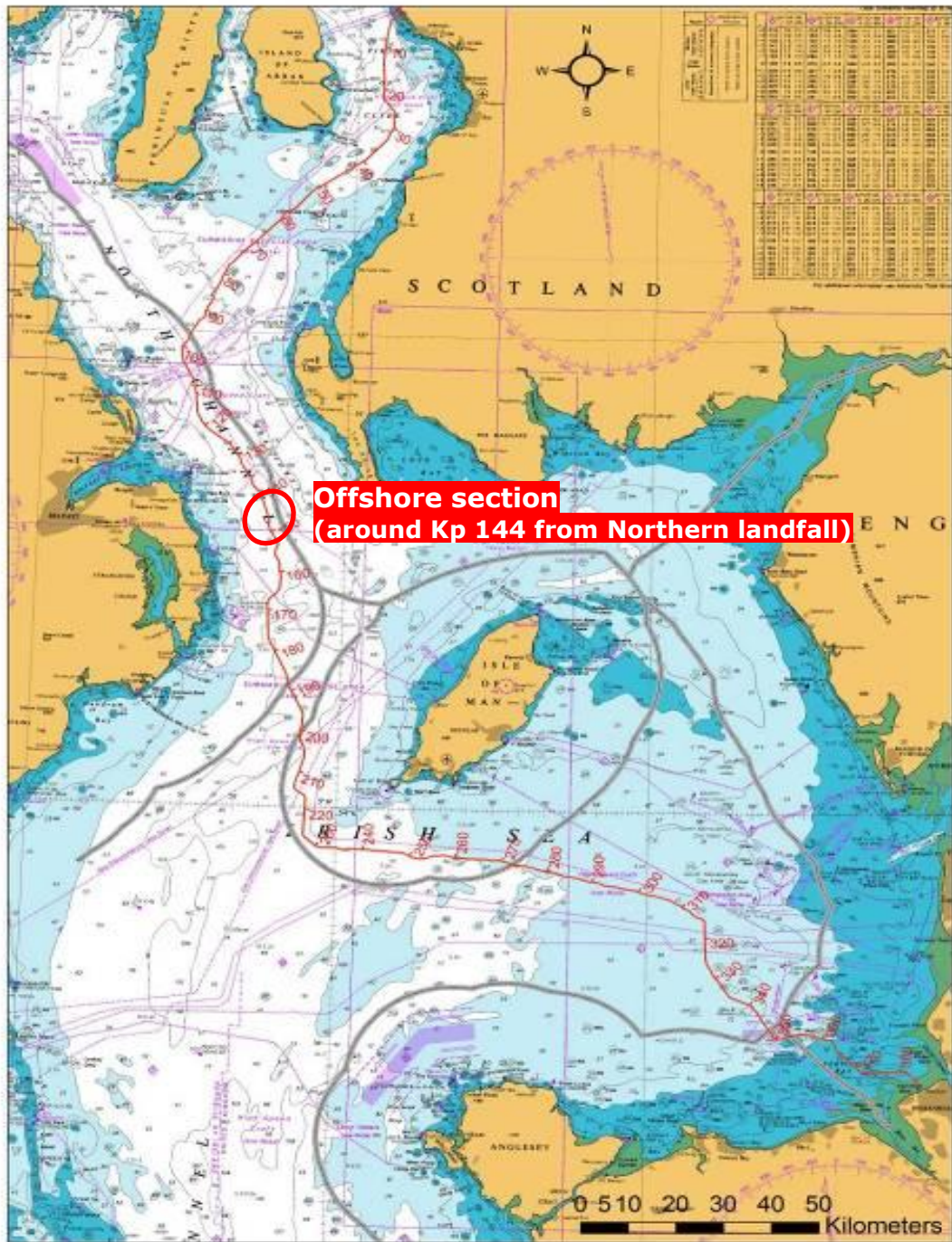


Figure 1 - Western Link cable route – Offshore section
