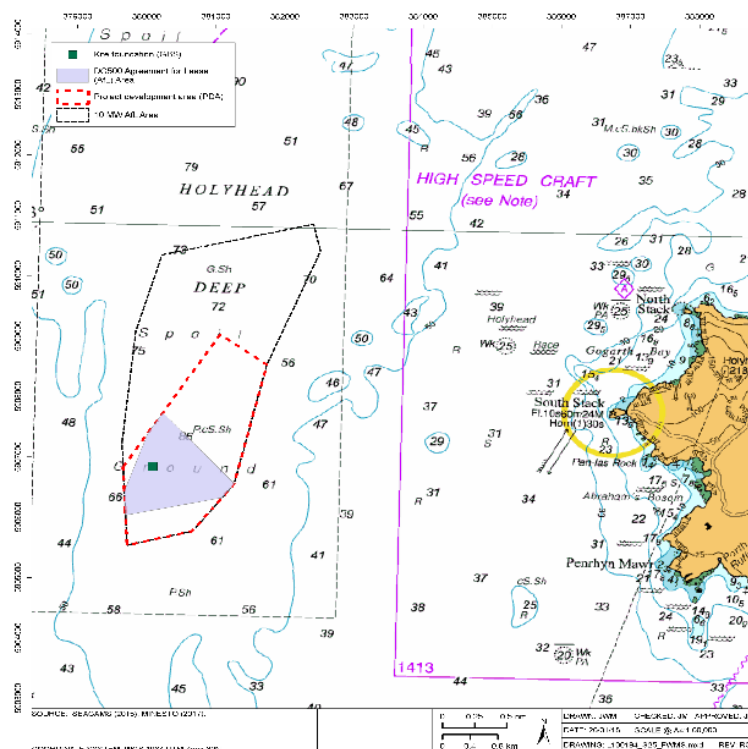

MOVEMENT OF THE MGS BUOY TO HOLYHEAD HARBOUR

As part of the ongoing development program, and to facilitate routine maintenance and system upgrades, the **MINESTO MGS BUOY** has been temporarily removed from its position (53° 17' 47.739" N 004° 47' 45.493" W) in the company's Agreement for Lease (Afl) area in the Holyhead Deep (Details below).

Overview of the Operational Area

The MGS Buoy has been temporarily removed from a position approximately 6 km West of South Stack, off the coast of Anglesey, North West Wales, in the southern section of the Afl area to the inner harbour of the Port of Holyhead.

The MGS Buoy is a yellow structure, 7m high, 6m diameter and has a draft of 10m. It has an all-round light YELLOW FI(4).15s
