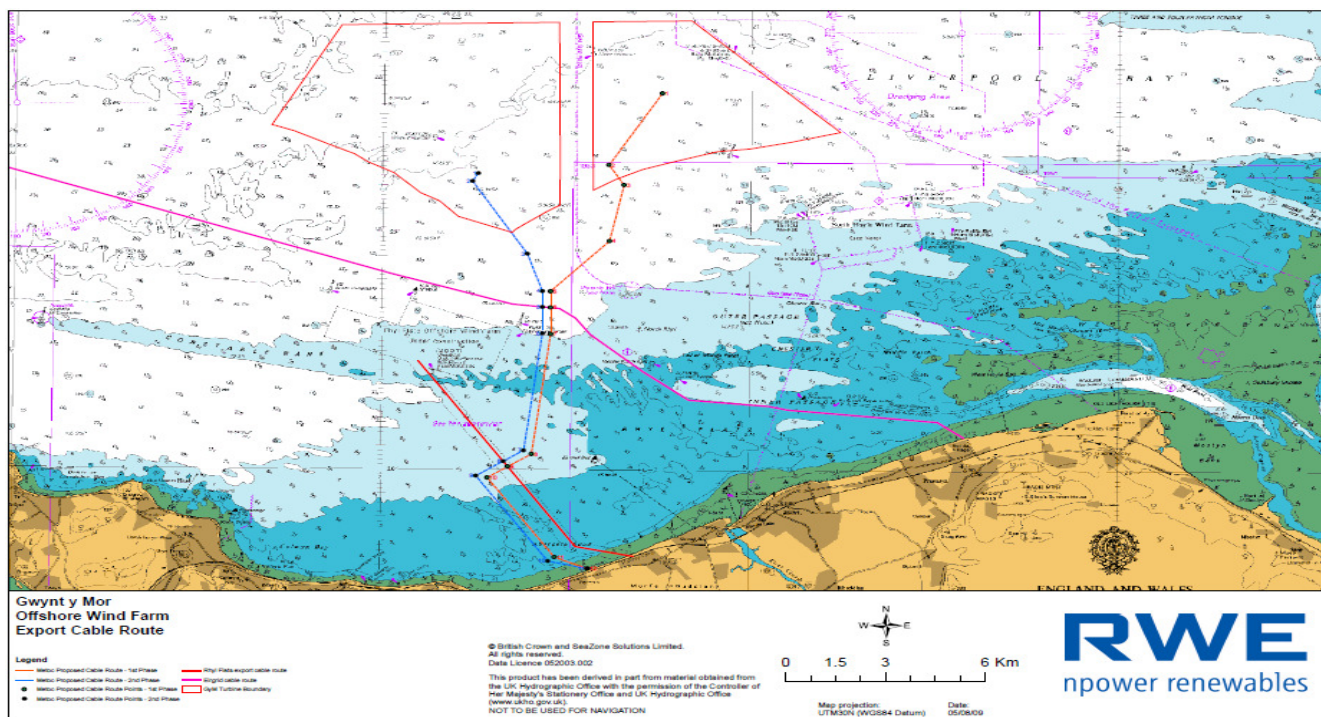

Please be advised that the Global Marine Systems Cable Laying Barge “Cable Enterprise” has had to abandon the cable laying plough along with some umbilical in the position:

Lat – 53 degrees 21.87 minutes north.

Lon – 3 degrees 35.79 minutes west.

This location is approx 4.2 nautical miles north of Pensarn beach and 2 nautical miles west of the “middle patch spit” port hand lateral buoy.

The water depth at LAT is approx 5m.

The dimensions of the plough are 10m in length and 4.5m in height.

All vessels are advised to keep at least 1000m clear of this location until further notice.

Holyhead MRCC is issuing a local navigation warning every 3 hours.

RWE npower renewables guard vessel “MV Choice” is on location and also broadcasting an on site navigation warning to all traffic.

This will be in place until Global Marine Systems have their own dedicated guard vessel on duty.

MV Choice and Holyhead MRCC can be contacted on VHF 16.
