Please be advised that RWE Renewables UK will be carrying out maintenance operations including heavy lift operations at the Gwynt y Môr Offshore Wind Farm situated off the North Wales Coast.

Operations will take place at G16E (53°27.44667N, 3°30.64817W), A04B(53°29.44033N, 3°33.92533W), D06B(53°28.4325N, 3°34.23317W)

Start date is expected to be on or around the 25th September, with an expected duration of approximately 2 weeks subject to weather.
